“Pure Homeopathy in Cases with Severe Pathologies and Comparative Materia Medica” with Dr. André Saine

We would like to cordially invite you to this year's week-long, which will take place from **Sunday 27th September to Saturday 3rd October 2020** in Niendorf/Timmendorfer Strand on the Baltic Sea coast. The event consists of a 3- or 6-day course and a one-day practical workshop on the topic of vaccination.

To guarantee a maximum relevance to practice, this year's course will – as in the previous years – present interesting cases from the practice of Dr. André Saine with the focus on cancer and other severe pathologies. The focus is on a systematic training of the participants to identify the totality of the essential aspects of a case – the **genius of the case**. For an optimized learning effect, all paper cases will be sent in advance to the participants for self-study. A broader spectrum is planned for this year, i.e. not only cancer cases but also other serious pathologies. A **live anamnesis** (on site or via Skype conference) will complement this training. The precise and comprehensive case-taking process of André Saine is time and again very instructive and impressive, even for advanced practitioners.

Within the framework of the international 'Materia Medica Pura Project' (MMPP), under the direction of André Saine, work has been underway for over ten years on the systematic processing and updating of the homeopathic materia medica and the repertory. During the seminar week, the results of the MMPP (Materia medica lectures) will be presented as before, with a special focus on the presentation of the genius of the remedy and its differentiation from other similar remedies.

Dr. André Saine



Dr. André Saine lives and works in Montréal, Canada. He is a graduate of the National College of Naturopathic Medicine in Portland, Oregon and Dean of the Canadian Academy of Homeopathy since 1986. He has been teaching extensively for more than 25 years' genuine homeopathy in North America and Europe.

Because of his encyclopaedic knowledge of materia medica, his precise and sensitive case taking techniques and his case analyses, which are easy to understand and free of speculative interpretations, André Saine has the reputation of being one of the world's best homeopaths. He is an alert, widely read, immensely busy and above all a very personable colleague with a lively and engaging lecturing style.

Planned programme

- Optional one-day focus day on the topic of **vaccination** (27.9.2020).
- Presentation of different remedies by André Saine. Planned remedies are Symphytum, Sabal serrulata, Hecla lava, Lapis albus and Sedum acre.
- Live anamnesis and analysis.
- Presentation of more homeopathic remedies worked on by participants of the MMPP together with André Saine. It is not yet possible to say which remedies will be ready for presentation.
- The brief summaries of polychrests, that initially began three years ago, will also be continued this year. Summaries of Cantharis and Bryonia have already been planned plus further remedies.
- Practical advice regarding parallel measures and lifestyle.

Practical information about the course

- To make it easier for newcomers to get started, we offer the possibility of attending the course for three days only, from September 28th to 30th 2020. During these days, the focus is on the live case-taking and its analysis as well as practice-oriented lessons. If necessary, an introduction will be offered for newcomers on Sunday evening (27.9.2020). Moreover, experienced colleagues are willing to help with any problems in understanding.
- The course is suitable for experienced homeopaths as well as for beginners, and both will benefit according to their own level of knowledge.
- The course language is English. As André Saine is French-Canadian his first language is French which means he speaks an easy-to-understand English.
- **Included** in the fees are breacktime snacks, the collective lunch (buffet at the hotel Atlantic opposite the course venue) and two social evening events.
- Because of limited number of places available, it is recommended to book early. After May 15th 2020 booking is also open for the 3- or 4-day course.
- **Reductions in fees** are available only on request for the unemployed or for financially weak participants and also for participants from countries with lower income standards.
- German doctors should give us their barcodes as the 7-day course is expected to be certified with 61 points by the German Medical Association (Ärztammer).

Course venue

Haus des Kurgastes, Strandstraße 121a, DE-23669 Niendorf/Ostsee. The course venue is located directly on the beach.

Course times

Daily from 9.00 to ca. 18.30 with a lunch break from 12.30 to 14.30. Half-hour breaks in the mornings and afternoons. Admission to the course venue from 8.00 on the first and second day and from 8.30 on the following days. On the last day the course finishes at 16.00. On Saturday evening, an optional dinner will be held in a restaurant for those who leave on Sunday.

Accommodation

Accommodation is the participant's responsibility. We recommend the Hotel Atlantic opposite the course venue that also offers very attractive room rates for the participants. Please mention that you are a participant of the course when booking there.

We advise booking accommodation as soon as possible as there are still many tourists on vacation in late September/early October. Please also take a look at our document with further accommodation possibilities. Please inform your landlord that, as a congress participant, you are exempt from paying the usual tourist-tax.
